WHAT'S NEW THIS ROUND?

Dunlop will support seven Japanese teams in Formula EWC plus two full-season EWC teams travelling from Europe: BMW Motorrad World Endurance Team and KM99.

The Superstock class also includes seven teams that have chosen Dunlop, including the TONE RT SYNCEDGE 4413 BMW which finished on the podium last year.

The Dunlop operation includes expertise from Europe and Japan, bringing a range of tires from both regions to ensure every team receives familiar products and support throughout the event.

Despite being the shortest race distance of the season, Suzuka's unique 'figure of 8' layout and its variety of corners makes for a tough challenge.

The Esses that dominate the first sector give way to a series of technical and tight corners, including a slow hairpin, before riders make their way round to the long back straight and the fast sweeping left-hander at turn 15. The lap finishes with a tight chicane that gives overtaking opportunities onto the main straight.

Starting at 11:30 local time (04:30 CEST) on Sunday 6 August, the race will run for eight hours until 19:30. Sunset is timed for 18:52, meaning the final stint will run in dusk.

After Suzuka, the EWC season wraps up with the Bol d'Or 24-hour race at Le Castellet, France, on 16-17 September.
